



Overview of the Queer Food Employment Training Program

The Queer Food Employment Training Program has been created with the support of the ACT Government's Office of LGBTIQ+ Affairs Connection Grant Program.

The program has three clear objectives. Firstly, it will offer the opportunity for casual employment with on-the-job training with co-created goals, that will be recorded in a logbook with regular progress check-ins.

Secondly, it will offer the 6 external monthly training sessions which will cover an array of topics from industry related skills to broader areas including inclusivity, storytelling, workplace safety and creativity with food.

Thirdly, the program will allow trainees to be a part of an ongoing Queer Food community and network in person and online, with access to a community Facebook group where additional resources will be shared and support provided.
